September 28 (Friday)	Juniors should meet with HIS 400 instructor during office hours to discuss JP topic(s) individually <u>by this date at the latest</u>
December 7 (Friday)	Juniors submit partial first draft to HIS 400 instructor of at least 10 pages , <u>by this date at the latest</u>
December 14 (Friday)	Students receive partial first drafts back, with comments
January 8, 2019 (Tuesday)	Final JP Due Online by 5:00 p.m. You will receive instructions in December on where to upload the paper

NB: Over the course of the semester, students will also be required to submit an annotated bibliography (of primary and secondary sources), an outline, and a prospectus.

All written work submitted in the course of the semester should properly cite and attribute any ideas and information that are not the student's own to the sources from which they have been derived. Failure to do so constitutes plagiarism.

The Honor Pledge should accompany each piece of work submitted:
