| Date | Deadline |

| September 18 (Friday) | Juniors should meet with HIS 400 instructor to discuss JP topic(s) <u>by this date at the latest</u> |
| November 24 (Tuesday) | Juniors complete partial first draft of at least 10 pages <u>by this date at the latest</u> |
| December 8 (Friday) | Full draft due to instructor. (Expect comments back within a week.) |
| January 15, 2021 (Tuesday) [<i>University set deadline</i>] | Final JP Due Online by 5:00 p.m. You will receive instructions in December on where to upload the paper |

NB: Over the course of the semester, students will also be required to submit an annotated bibliography (of primary and secondary sources), an outline, and a prospectus.
